RULES AND REGULATIONS

- I. Madrassah hours are 5:00pm - 6:45pm and 6:30pm - 7:30pm, Monday to Friday. Please note that the timings are subject to change and parents will be notified if timings do change.
- II. Students are required to be in the Madrassah five minutes before the start time. Parents must ensure that students arrive on time. Tardiness without a valid excuse will not be tolerated.
- III. Parents are required to inform the administration if a student will be arriving late. This also applies if the student will be absent for the day.
- IV. Continued absence without notice may result in expulsion.
